Resolution #024/10/11 Caustic Soda Extension WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Water Authority of Western Nassau County (hereinafter "Water Authority") by Resolution authorized the execution of a one year contract with a one year option, to be exercised in the sole discretion of the Water Authority, to supply caustic soda (25% sodium hydroxide) and caustic soda (8% sodium hydroxide) to the Water Authority, in accordance with its requirements; and

WHEREAS, Article 9 of the aforesaid contract, dated November 13, 2009, provides the Water Authority with the option to elect to extend the terms of the contract for an additional one year term, upon written notice provided not later than ninety days prior to the expiration of the contract; and

WHEREAS, a written recommendation was sent to the Board of Directors by Robert Swartz of the Water Authority, recommending extending the terms of the aforesaid contract for an additional one year term;

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of R. Sakowich, seconded by M. Wohlgemuth,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Water Authority be and hereby is authorized to transmit written notification to JCI Jones Chemicals of the Water Authority's exercise of its option to extend the terms of the aforesaid contract for an additional one year term.
