WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Water Authority of Western Nassau County by public notice duly published according to law, invited sealed bid proposals for a one year contract with a one year option, to be exercised in the sole discretion of the Water Authority of Western Nassau County, to supply caustic soda (25% sodium hydroxide) and caustic soda (8% sodium hydroxide) to the Water Authority of Western Nassau County, in accordance with its requirements; and

WHEREAS, all such bid proposals received were opened and read publicly by

the Water Authority of Western Nassau County, 58 Tyson Avenue, Floral Park, New York, on the 5th day of October, 2011 at 10:30 o'clock A.M. the time and place specified in the public notice; and

WHEREAS, upon such review of such bid proposals by the Water Authority of Western Nassau County, a written recommendation was sent to the Board of Directors by Robert Swartz, of the Water Authority of Western Nassau County, stating that JCI Jones Chemicals Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder meeting the bid specifications and recommending award of the contract thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Water Authority of Western Nassau County has determined that JCI Jones Chemicals Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder meeting the bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, JCI Jones Chemicals Inc. failed to submit a bid for caustic soda 8% Sodium Hydroxide; and

WHEREAS, the Water Authority recommends that the Board of Directors waive the irregularity of the bid for failing to submit a quote for the caustic soda 8% Sodium Hydroxide based upon the fact that it is not anticipated that the Water Authority will need a delivery during the contract term;
