Resolution #078/13/14 - Civil Service Appointment

WHEREAS, the Water Authority of Western Nassau County (hereinafter "Water Authority") has received a memorandum from Janice Varley, Director of Human Resources, recommending that the Water Authority hire Shitique Webster to fill the vacated full-time position of Water Plant Attendant, a civil service labor class position; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid memo recommends the hiring of Shitique Webster as a Water Plant Attendant at a compensation rate of \$19.09 per hour with a 26 week probationary period;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion of G. Bakich, seconded by M. Wohlgemuth;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Water Authority hereby appoints Shitique Webster to the full-time position of Water Plant Attendant at a compensation rate of \$19.09 per hour plus benefits, with a 26 week probationary period and subject to approval by the Nassau County Department of Civil Service; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors authorizes the Chairman of the Water Authority to execute any and all documents required by the Nassau County Department of Civil Service to complete the appointment of Shitique Webster to the full-time position of Water Plant Attendant.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Water Authority is desirous of assigning the defense of the action to the firm of Minerva & D'Agostino, P.C. as additional services at the rates stated in the aforesaid retainer agreement;
