WHEREAS, Article 9 of the aforesaid contract provides the Water Authority with the option to elect to extend the terms of the contract for an additional one year term, upon written notice provided not later than ninety day prior to the expiration of the contract; and

**WHEREAS** a written recommendation was sent to the Board of Directors by Robert Swartz, Chief Engineer of the Water Authority, recommending extending the terms of the aforesaid contract for an additional one year term;

**NOW THEREFORE**, upon motion of M. Wohlgemuth, seconded by R. Sakowich,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Chairman of the Water Authority be and hereby is authorized to transmit written notification to Shannon Chemical Corporation of the Water Authority's exercise of its option to extend the terms of the aforesaid contract for an additional one year term.

**WHEREAS**, all such bid proposals received were opened and read publicly by the Water Authority, 1580 Union Turnpike, New Hyde Park, New York on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2015 at 10:30 o'clock AM, the time and place specified in the public notice; and

WHEREAS, upon review of such bid proposals by the Water Authority, a written recommendation was sent to the Board of Directors by Thomas J. Mulzoff, Director of T&D Operations of the Water Authority, stating that Ferguson Enterprises was the lowest responsible bidder meeting the bid specifications and recommending award of the contract thereto; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the Water Authority has determined that Ferguson Enterprises is the lowest responsible bidder meeting the bid specifications.

**NOW THEREFORE**, upon motion of M. Wohlgemuth, seconded by S. Powderly,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the bid proposal of Ferguson Enterprises be and the same is hereby accepted; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Chairman of the Water Authority be and hereby is authorized to execute a one year contract with Ferguson Enterprises to supply Mueller Super Centurion 250 Fire Hydrants to the Water Authority, in accordance with its requirements, for the prices specified in said bid proposal and in accordance with the bid specifications for said contract.
