WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Water Authority has determined that Pace Analytical Laboratories is the lowest responsible bidder meeting the bid specifications;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the bid proposal of Pace Analytical Laboratories be and the same is hereby accepted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Water Authority be and hereby is authorized to execute a one year contract with a one year option, to be exercised in the sole discretion of the Water Authority, with Pace Analytical Laboratories to perform laboratory services for the Water Authority, in accordance with its requirements, for the prices specified in said bid proposal and in accordance with the bid specifications for said contract.

Resolution #085/15/16 - Emergency Replacement of Well Pumps Nos. 16A and 44A

WHEREAS, a memorandum was sent to the Board of Directors of the Water Authority of Western Nassau County (hereinafter "Water Authority"), by Joseph Corbisiero, Director Plant Operations of the Water Authority advising the Board of Directors that the contractor, A.C. Schultes, Inc., whose services were engaged to remove/inspect the Well Pumps at Wells16A and 44A, completed the removal/inspection and indicated that repairs were necessary to fix the operating issues with said well pumps; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid memorandum states that A. C. Schultes, Inc. provided a proposal to perform the required repairs to correct the operating issues and return Well Pumps 16A and 44A back into service in the sum of \$71,812.00 and further recommended declaring the repairs an emergency in order to meet the quality and quantity of water needs of the Water Authority's customers in the areas of these wells; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Water Authority has determined that an emergency repair is required and that contracting with A. C. Schultes, Inc. to complete the repairs is in the best interests of the Water Authority;

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of D. Longobardi, seconded by B. Brown,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the proposal of A. C. Schultes, Inc. to perform the repairs to correct the operating issues and return Well Pumps 16A and 44A back into service in the sum of \$71,812.00 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Water Authority is authorized to execute a public works contract with A. C. Schultes, Inc. to perform the repairs in a form satisfactory to counsel to the Water Authority.
