WHEREAS, a memorandum has been received by the Board of Directors from Alan Kolakowski, Director, Accounting, Planning & Customer Service of the Water Authority, recommending execution of a contract with S.L.C. Meter East, Inc. for the purchase of Neptune water meters for a term of five years;
