WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 5, Title 8-C, Section 1198-f(21) of the Public Authorities Law, a Public Hearing was commenced by the Water Authority on May 22, 2023 with respect to fixing rates and for the collection of water service charges; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Public Hearing was held upon not less than fourteen days notice thereof to each customer by publication once in a newspaper having general circulation within the district;
