The Water Authority has an active project to address emerging contaminants, including perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), perfluorooctanesulfonic acid (PFOS), and 1,4-Dioxane

In early 2021 a letter was sent to all customers regarding a deferral issued for PFOA, PFOS and 1,4-Dioxane.
